

McNair Travel Club Rules on the Road

Successful group travel relies upon considerate behavior from all participants. Please remember that you are a representative of your school while you're traveling. You need to be punctual and attentive to your group leader, who is responsible for everyone in the group. You also need to respect your tour director, who will handle all of the logistics of your trip.

YOU MUST CAREFULLY ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WHILE ON TOUR:

1. All scheduled activities are obligatory. A participant unable to attend due to a physical ailment must inform his or her group leader. Do not wander off alone. If you miss the group, **STAY PUT UNTIL SOMEONE GETS YOU!**
2. If students wish to visit friends or relatives in a destination, the group leader must be informed before the tour begins. A letter from your parent must be signed giving authorization for such visits.
3. Visitors or group members of the opposite sex are not permitted in students' rooms. The curfew will be established by the group leader (usually 11:30pm). Students are expected to respect the nightly curfew for their own safety and security. Room checks will be conducted each night.
4. Smoking is not allowed on buses, during meals, in hotel rooms or in any other shared, enclosed space. Smoking is not allowed for any student.
5. Hitchhiking and the driving or renting of any motor vehicle are strictly forbidden for all travelers.
6. The consumption of hard liquor is strictly forbidden. Drinking by any participant will result in disciplinary action, including dismissal from the tour at the participant's expense.
7. Shoplifting, possession of illegal drugs and all other illegal activities will not be tolerated and are punishable by immediate dismissal from the tour. All costs to return home are at the participant's expense. Should the local authorities be involved, participants will be subject to the laws of the city they are visiting.
8. Participants are required to pay for any phone calls or incidental personal expenses incurred at hotels. These will be payable the evening before departure at each hotel.
9. Compensation for damage done to hotel rooms or to buses is the responsibility of the participants.
10. Tipping is mandatory. Set aside \$25 in an envelope with your name & school for the bus driver & tour guide.
11. Sleep on the bus as much as possible. Sleeping during activities is out of the question. Participate in everything!
12. **BE FLEXIBLE & COMPROMISE!** We all want to enjoy the trip!
13. Keep valuable jewelry at home! Be mindful of personal valuables.
14. **ENJOY YOURSELF & MAKE SURE MS. HASTIE DOES TOO!**


